DID YOU KNOW THAT...?



... **nearly half** of the parents (47%)

reported that the child was affected by **breathing pauses (apnoea)** for at least one or more days



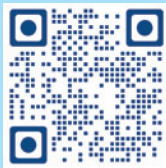
... more than **44%** of all parents

felt often or always guilty for not having prevented the RSV infection of the child



... more than **39%** of all parents

reported that family activities **often or almost always** took up **more time and effort** due to the child's hospitalisation



Severe **RSV** infections with hospitalisation represent a considerable burden for the entire family.
